

Who are you to judge?

Matthew 7:1-6

¹“Judge not, that you be not judged. ²For with the judgment you pronounce you will be judged, and with the measure you use it will be measured to you. ³Why do you see the speck that is in your brother’s eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? ⁴Or how can you say to your brother, ‘Let me take the speck out of your eye,’ when there is the log in your own eye? ⁵You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother’s eye. ⁶“Do not give dogs what is holy, and do not throw your pearls before pigs, lest they trample them underfoot and turn to attack you.”¹

❑ Who are YOU to judge? (1-5)

- Don’t be judgmental (1)
- God will judge us the same way we judge others (2)
- Examine your own life before speaking up (3-4)
- Act humbly when pointing out the faults of others (5)

❑ Who ARE you to judge? (6)

- Don’t be gullible. Not everyone is willing to listen to the truth.
